## **THE JURY'S DECISION**

All categories of the competition are evaluated by a Jury consisting of professional Russian specialists.

The following criteria will be taken into account when evaluating the performance: the degree of complexity of the program, performance skill, virtuosity, ensemble, nuance, strokes, sense of style, presentation of the program, originality, originality.

For their PERFORMANCE the Orchestra or ensemble RECEIVES ONE RATING from 0 to 10 POINTS

You can get a maximum of 30 points from three members of the jury.

The jury's decisions are indisputable. The possibility of judicial intervention is excluded.

In each category the JURY determines the places based on the points received:

### **GRAND PRIX**

the highest score of the competition Award 30,000 rubles, diploma of the Grand Prix

1st place 25-30 points - diploma of the Winner (I place)

2nd place 21-24 points-Diploma of the Winner (II place)

3rd place 16-20 points-Diploma of the Winner (III place)

Diploma holder 10-15 points-Diploma by category

Contestant 1 - 9 points Diploma for participation

The jury has the right to:

— do not award all prizes;

— do not award the Grand Prix;

- divide prize places (in disputed situations) within the prize Fund;

- award special Diplomas to the most outstanding participants.

According to the results of the competition, the winners (who scored the highest score) and holders of special prizes are determined:

\* prize for the best conductor of the competition;

\* prize for the best soloist / soloist;

The jury reserves the right to award additional special prizes or not to award any of the above.
